

The French Government has launched a new website to help British nationals living in France obtain French residency so that they can remain in France post Brexit.

British nationals who are already living in France can now apply online for a 'Carte de Séjour' in order to remain in France after the UK has left the EU. The website was launched as part of the French government's preparations for a no-deal Brexit and the site is currently in a test phase.

The website is in both French and English and explains that British nationals living in France will have 6 months following the UK's departure date to apply for a Residency permit. A residency permit will be mandatory for all British nationals living in France as of October 31, 2020.

If you are applying for a residency permit you will need to have a photograph or scan of your passport as well as several additional documents, depending on your situation, ready before starting the application process. More details can be found [here](#).
