British Chambers of Commerce TRADE CONFIDENCE OUTLOOK Q1 2021



The BCC's Trade Confidence Outlook (TCO) is the largest quarterly survey of UK exporters in the UK. It assesses the percentage of UK exporters reporting a change in overseas sales, investment, and confidence. The data for the TCO is drawn from the BCC's Quarterly Economic Survey (QES) – the UK's largest independent quarterly business survey – which receives responses from around 2,900 exporters from across the UK, from all sectors and sizes.

In Q1 2021, the results reveal the stark issues facing UK exporters in the first months of this year. The survey revealed that the percentage of exporters reporting decreased export sales had increased to 41%, up from 38% in the previous quarter. The percentage of businesses reporting increased export sales fell to 20%, down from 22% in Q4 2020. 40% reported no change in their export sales..

"Given that export sales are at some of the lowest levels ever recorded in the history of our data, the fact this situation is continuing to deteriorate is concerning. These new figures show that UK exporters are currently facing a range of issues that go beyond just those that have been created by the pandemic.

Many businesses are telling us that their ability to continue trading is at risk due to issues arising from the UK-EU TCA. In response, Government has taken a step in the right direction with the establishment of the £20 million SME Brexit Support Fund, although we believe the scale of ambition needs to be much greater.

Exporters want desperately to play their part in the UK economic recovery from Covid-19, but they are currently being hampered by issues outside of their control. Government must take further steps to bolster the UK export sector and unleash its potential to help power economic growth in the aftermath of the current crisis."
